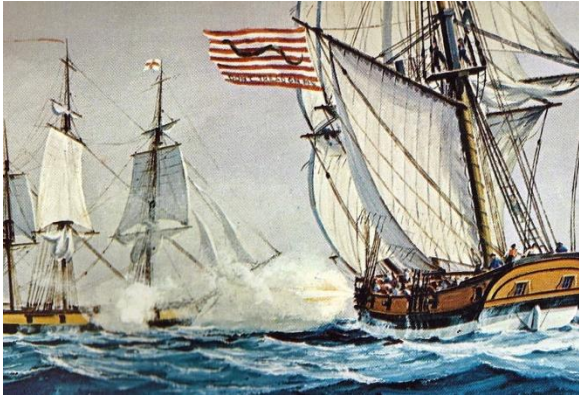


Federal Point Historic Preservation Society Events Calendar Summer/Fall 2018

Program: Ben Wunderly, from the North Carolina Maritime Museum at Beaufort, will talk about the history of surfing along the North Carolina coast.

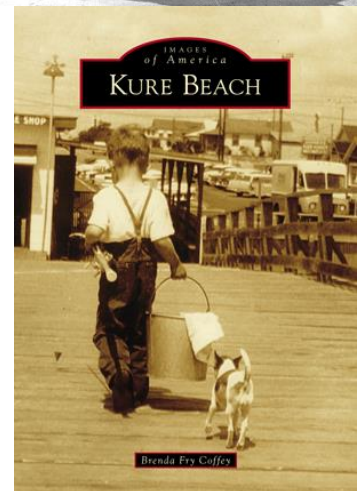
