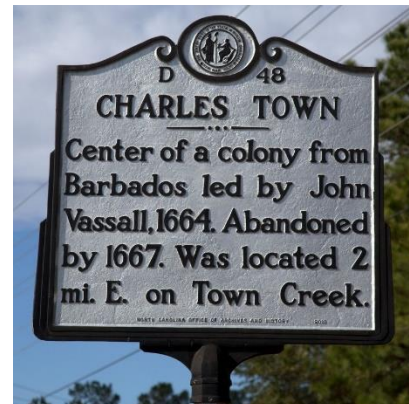


Federal Point Historic Preservation Society Events Calendar Summer/Fall 2019



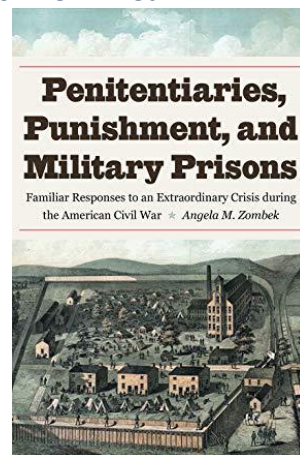

Monday, August 19, 2019: 7:30-9:00 pm. Program: Local teacher, publisher, historian, and consummate storyteller, Jack Fryar, returns to talk about the original "Charles Town" which was located in nearby Brunswick County and settled well before Charleston, SC.

Program: Becky Sawyer, historic interpreter with the Fort Fisher State Historic Site, will talk on her research into the history of the Federal Point Lighthouse which resulted in the new exhibit featuring the three lighthouses that were built as aids to navigation for New Inlet.
